## **Requirements for The Licensing of Drones in Barbados**

All applicants must submit the following when applying for a licence to operate a drone in Barbados

- 1) A letter from the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) giving permission to operate a drone in Barbados
- 2) Proof of public liability insurance of at least BDS \$250,000.00 coverage for the territory of Barbados for accidents that may occur while using the drone.
  - a) The insurance must cover the entire period of the drone licence and must be submitted to the PMO, and also to the Telecommunications Unit if permission is granted by the PMO.
- 3) Public liability insurance is required for the renewal of drone licences

**Conditions governing the licensing and operation of all UAVs and Radio-Controlled Models in Barbados (Regulations 2002)**

- (1) The License fee for a drone or Model Licence is BDS \$30.00
- (2) A visitor who is staying in Barbados and who wish to use their drone or Model while staying in Barbados can apply for a temporary licence. If the licence is for a drone they must satisfy the requirements shown on page 3
- (3) Licences that are not temporary expire on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December and must be renewed on or before that date if the licence is still required
- (4) A licence may be withdrawn if any condition (e.g. Non-payment of renewal fees) is not observed
- (5) The operation of this station must not cause harmful interference with any radio communication service.
- (6) The frequencies nominated in the licence should not be regarded as permanent. They may have to be altered from time to time as change in frequency planning takes place or as new developments are introduced in the design of equipment.
- (7) The station shall be operated only
  - (1) by the licensee personally or
  - (2) in the presence of and under the direct supervision of the licensee.
- (8) It is prohibited to hold exhibitions as distinct from normal club activities without the permission of the Chief Telecommunications Officer.
- (9) The following paragraphs apply to the licensee of drones and UAVs only:
  - a. It is prohibited to fly drones and UAVs over a residential area, a public highway or within a 3-mile radius of Grantley Adams International Airport.
  - b. The Licensee must be over 14 years.
