**TELECOMMUNICATIONS (SATELLITE TELEVISION
RECEIVER ANTENNA) REGULATIONS, 2003**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 110(1) of the *Telecommunications Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Telecommunications (Satellite Television Receiver Antenna) Regulations, 2003*.

2. In these Regulations,

"antenna" means a satellite television receiver antenna that receives but does not transmit television communication by means of electromagnetic carrier waves.

3. These Regulations do not apply to antenna used by Multi-Choice Television (MCTV), Direct Television or Domestic Television.

4. A person who is desirous of operating an antenna may

(a) on application to the Minister in the form set out in Part I of the *Schedule*; and

(b) on payment of the relevant fee specified in the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations, 2003*,

obtain a licence for the purpose.

5. A licence issued under regulation 4

(a) shall be in the form set out in the Part II of the *Schedule* and shall be subject to such conditions as are specified in the licence; and

(b) is not transferable.

6. A licensee shall not
- (a) use his antenna or cause his premises on which an antenna is installed to be used in such a way as to cause interference with the television or radio service of others;
 - (b) use or cause his antenna to be used for commercial purposes; and
 - (c) use his antenna or his premises for the reception or transmission of images and sound by cable or other means, to any premises other than those for which he is licensed.

7. (1) Subject to regulation 8, a licence issued under regulation 4, in respect of business premises on which an antenna is installed, shall expire one year from the date of the issue of the licence, and is renewable on payment of the fee specified in the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations, 2003* during the month following the date of expiration.

(2) There shall be paid in respect of a licence issued under regulation 4 in relation to domestic premises, such fee as is prescribed under the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations, 2003*.

8. Where a licensee fails to comply with any provision of these Regulations or with any of the conditions referred to in regulation 6, the Minister may cancel or refuse to renew the licence.

9. Where the Minister revokes a licence under regulation 8, the licensee may make an application for a review of the decision in accordance with section 104 of the Act.

3) A licence issued under this regulation will be subject to a late payment fee of 25% of the licence fee if the licence remains unpaid for a period greater than 30 days after the notification of payment.

**Restriction in respect of Satellite Television
Receiver Antenna**

1. No person shall install, keep or use a satellite television receiver antenna except in accordance with the terms and conditions of a licence issued in accordance with the *Satellite Television Receiver (Antenna) Regulations, 2003*.
2. Any person who has been granted a licence for the installation, keeping or use a satellite television antenna:
 - (a) shall not use or cause the antenna to be used for any commercial purpose;
 - (b) shall not use the antenna on the premises for the reception or transmission of images and sound by cable or other means to any premises other than those specified in the application for the licence; and
 - (c) shall not make any modifications to or use any device on the antenna for transmission of images or sound or for any purpose other than the reception of images and sound.

**LICENCE TO OPERATE A SATELLITE
TELEVISION RECEIVER ANTENNA**

Pursuant to the provisions of the *Telecommunications Act, Act 2001-36* and the *Telecommunications (Satellite Television Receiver Antenna) Regulations, 2003*, and in conformity with the Convention of the International Television Union _____ of _____ hereinafter called the "Licensee" is hereby licensed to install, keep or use a Satellite Television Receiver Antenna at _____ from _____ until _____ subject to the conditions stated overleaf.

CONDITIONS

The licence to install, keep or use a satellite television receiver antenna is issued subject to the following conditions:

1. The Licensee shall not install, keep or use a satellite television receiver antenna except in accordance with the *Telecommunications Act, 2001-36*, the *Telecommunications (Satellite Television Receiver Antenna) Regulations, 2003* and the conditions contained in the licence.
2. The Licensee shall not:
 - (1) use his antenna or cause his premises on which the antenna is installed to be used in such a way as to cause interference with the television or radio service of others;
 - (2) use or cause his antenna to be used for commercial purposes;
 - (3) use his antenna or his premises for the reception or transmission of images and sound cable or other means, to any premises other than those for which he is licensed;
 - (4) make any modification to or use device on his antenna for the purpose of using the antenna for the transmission of images or sound or for any purpose other than the reception of images and sound.
